DCC Tips and Tricks...

Our How-To demo for this month will be how to use a little-known feature of the LokSound decoder called Auto-Tune to dial in slow speed performance and even do rapid speed matching.

In addition to the How-To, I also have a very important tip to share this month. If you use the LokSound Select decoders and have struggled to get the sound files loaded or to edit the CV settings, add a low-value resistor (a 33-ohm, 1/2 watt works well for me) in series with one leg of the connection between the programmer and track.
